Parish to enable us to carry such intention into effect, and whereas the ship called the Preston will sail from Yarmouth in the course of a few days we request the favour and hope that this Parish will be pleased to take such means as may enable us to embrace the offered opportunity by going on Board the said Ship, or any other, as soon as conveniently may be.

In proof of our earnest intention of Emigrating To America we have heretofore set our hands and hereby bind ourselves to carry this Engagement into full effect as soon as the means are provided for our so doing.
